Photo ID is required from anyone wishing to pick up a camper. If you need a CAMPER RELEASE form, please call the office and request one. We occasionally have campers who make arrangements to go home with friends in camp. We need written notes from both guardians in this case, or we will not be able to accommodate this.

**FROM THE DIRECTOR:**

**Anyone who needs to pick up a child from camp must be at the camp no later than 3:45pm. If you are not here by that time, your child will be put on the bus.**

**Bus drivers are instructed to wait no more than 3 minutes at a house for a camper. To wait longer than that causes a delay for everyone else. Please make sure your child(ren) are ready a few minutes before their scheduled pick up time.**

**Young People's Day Camp is not responsible for any electronic devices, including cell phones, that are brought to camp. Such devices should be left home or given to children who can assume responsibility for them, which includes not using them during camp.**
