Good news! On June 2nd, Governor Cuomo announced that camps will be able to open this summer. Accordingly, preparations for a safe opening of YPDC are progressing rapidly. While awaiting final approval, we have received health & safety guidelines from the CDC & ACA which will be implemented and followed.

What we know:

- Masks may be worn by campers based on parental discretion.**
- Distancing guidelines will be followed, for all activities as well as arrival & dismissal.**
- Health screenings will be implemented for campers and staff, including temperature checks.**
- Extra cleaning and disinfecting of the facility, as well as all equipment .**
- Hand washing will be emphasized and monitored**
- Medical personnel will be on premises & a medical office to treat ill campers will be utilized.**
- Parental notification protocols will be created and adhered to.**
- Payment arrangements for new enrollments will be extended.**
